HTML & XML Exercise

Metadata is structured data which describes the characteristics of a resource. The term "meta" derives from the Greek word denoting a nature of a higher order or more fundamental kind. A metadata record consists of a number of predefined elements representing specific attributes of a resource, and each element can have one or more values.

In this exercise, you need to publish a simple **GIS metadata file to an XML and HTML format**. Any acceptable GIS metadata can be used in this exercise. The objective of this exercise is to practice and understand the structure of XML and HTML language.
